COUPLES SOUGHT FOR STUDY OF EVERYDAY COLLABORATION

My name is Jennifer Margrett, and I am a Professor in the Department of Human Development and Family Studies at Iowa State. Together Cindy Reese-Melancon, an Associate Professor of Psychology at Oklahoma State University, and I lead PROPEL (Prospection and Partnership in Everyday Life), a research study funded by the National Institutes of Health.

PROPEL is currently recruiting couples to participate in this research study and contribute to the scientific understanding of how partners collaborate to accomplish everyday tasks in middle and older adulthood. This program of research can have a lasting impact on health and well-being by revealing how partners work together to promote optimal aging and independent living. We invite you and your partner to participate in PROPEL!

Our goal is to survey couples over the course of four years and conduct two in-person sessions. Given that this project is launching during COVID, we will begin with online or mail-in surveys and ask participants to complete a survey and online task twice yearly. We will ask participants to participate in two "live" sessions: (a) one is an in-person session at the Iowa State University Research Park or a community location near your home and (b) the second is an in-home component in which we ask participants to complete everyday tasks using a tablet or smartphone.

Eligibility:

- Partner age is within five years of one another.
- The couple has been married or in long-term relationship for at least 5 years.
- The couple lives together.
- The couple does not reside in a skilled nursing facility or health care center.
- Proficient in English.

Each potential study participant will complete a Telephonic Interview for Cognitive Status with a researcher to determine eligibility.
